Notes:

- The A, B, and C values in the "Result" column for Readiness to Proceed correspond to the three factors considered for this criteria, as described in 31 TAC section 363.1304:
 - Preliminary planning or design work has been completed or is not required
 - The applicant is able to begin implementing/constructing the project within 18 months of the application deadline
 - The applicant has acquired all water rights associated with the project, or none are required
- A "Wholesale" result under the Water Loss Threshold criteria indicates that the applicant is a wholesale water provider, and therefore the requirement to conduct water loss audits is not applicable.
- Scores shown in this table reflect calculations at the individual application level. For projects involving the joint participation of multiple entities, these will be averaged to produce a single overall score.
